



# From the Pastor

Dear Parish Community:

Today, the Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the theme of hospitality and welcome engage us. In the first reading from the Book of Genesis, we meet Abraham and Sarah. They are visited by strangers who seem to be journeying in the desert. Abraham offers them hospitality. He set food and drink out for them. Unknowingly, Abraham will discover that he has welcomed God to his tent. In the Gospel reading, we meet Martha and Mary. They are sisters of Lazarus. It seems that Jesus was friendly with this family. They welcome Jesus to their home and Martha, who is busy with the details of serving and cooking and Mary, her sister, who seems to be concerned with the guest, are welcoming Jesus who is God incarnate. God is welcomed in both stories by people who may have never known that the one to whom they were showing a kindness was God. They opened their door and their hearts to another person. Who knew it would be God?

Hospitality is an openness to others. Hospitality is a biblical theme. Today's readings stand in contrast to a number of other events in the life of Christ: Christmas story for example, where there is no room in the inn, the story of Jesus' rejection by the people of Nazareth and ultimately to the rejection of Jesus leading to his death and Resurrection. During the summer, many of us are greeting visitors, hosting parties, visiting others, it is often in the simple hospitality that we meet some very interesting people and grow from the experience.

To who do we show welcome? Here at Sacred Hearts & St. Stephen Church, it is my intention and direction to all of us to welcome everyone who comes through our doors. Our welcoming of others says a great deal about who we are and what we believe. Some people are visitors, some are curious, some are new in the parish, some are searching for a parish, some are searching for God, some will stay, some will be here for a long time and some for a short time, some will be Catholic, some not, some will be believers and some will not be believers, some will be married, some will be single, some will be divorced, whoever they are, wherever they come from, from whatever race, color or creed or sexual orientation, gay or straight, they may be, they are welcomed here by all of us. God's mercy is wide and all encompassing, so if you see someone in Church who is new, please say hello and welcome them. Doing this simple act means a great deal to the new person and a great deal for us who are seeking to continue to build the family of God.
