

Trinity Sunday – 6/7/20

Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday. There is only one God, and in God, there are three divine Persons -Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We call the 3 Persons of God, the Holy Trinity. Each divine Person of God is unique and equal to the others. When we profess our faith at Mass, using the Creed, we say that God the Father is the Creator. We also say that Jesus is the only Son of the Father, and that he came down from Heaven to save us by dying on the Cross and rising from the dead. We say too that the Holy Spirit is the giver of Life.

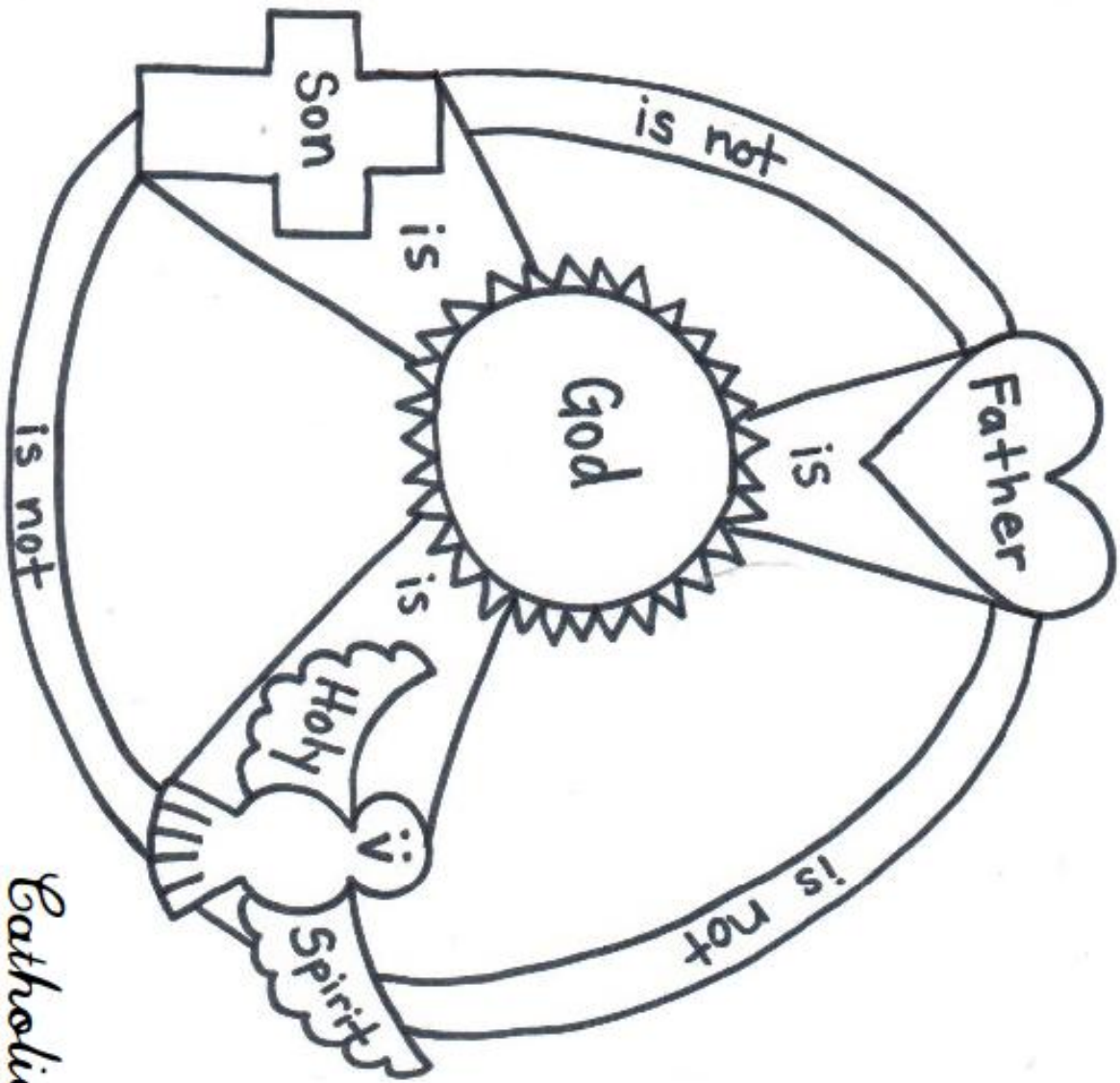
