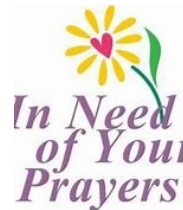

ALLELUIA CHRIST IS RISEN ALLELUIA

Dear Parish Family,

Alleluia! Christ is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! Indeed He is Risen Alleluia! In this one acclamation is our Good News for the today, tomorrow and forever. This is our Easter Faith which we have proclaimed for two thousand years. It is this faith that has empowered Christians to face persecutions, oppression and all forms of darkness. It is this Good News that gets us through Bad News that seems to assail us.

What do we mean when we say Christ is Risen? The resurrection of Christ does not mean Jesus was resuscitated.
