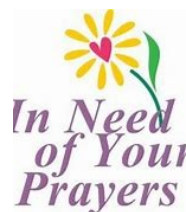

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Dear Parish Family,

Baptism is the way of becoming a disciple. In the second reading Paul speaks to us about baptism. Baptism is the most important of sacraments. Through baptism we become part of the body of Christ. (the Church) Through baptism we share in all that Jesus did. In baptism the Holy Spirit appropriates the redemption Christ accomplished through his death and resurrection to us. In Baptism the Holy Trinity dwells deep within us. Baptism is an adult commitment to Christ. We baptize children because of the request of believing parents. Parents take on a serious responsibility before God when they request the baptism of their child. They promise to pass the faith on to their children. To fulfill this obligation before God, the parent should be practicing the faith. In the end, the parent not the child is answerable to God for this obligation.
